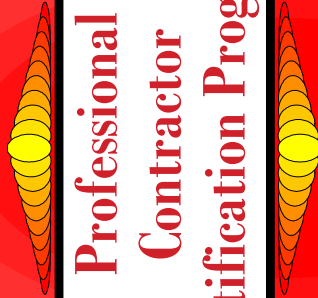

Professional Contractor Certification Program

The **NWSA** is pleased to launch a voluntary certification program for its members facilitating their designation as Professional Contractors. This designation will allow members to provide additional documentation as part of the RFP process.

NWSA aims to be a leader in our industry by providing ongoing education opportunities.

NWSA programs help our members stay current on changes in the laws and regulations that govern the private contracting in our industry.

Cost to Participate in the Program...

To participate you must first be a paid member of **NWSA**. (To join **NWSA**, visit www.nwsa.us). The cost to participate in the initial training program is \$100.00. The company owner or CEO must attend the initial training. We encourage additional management to participate at the cost of \$30.00 per person. The training is done annually at our **NWSA** conference.

How does the program work...

There are two phases. The first is an eight hour training session offered at the **NWSA** Annual Conference that includes the following:

- Basic Business Ethics
- USDOL - Regulations (MSPA, FARS)
- USDOT - Driver Regulations, Hours of Service
- Critical Management Guide
- Workers Compensation 101



The second phase of the program is maintaining your certification. To do this you must have eight hours of training documented per year.

There are two ways to do this:

1. Attend 8 hours of workshops at the **NWSA** Conference annually.
2. Attend training given locally by recognized agencies such as: DOT, DOL, OSHA, Workers Compensation carriers, or a state recognized community college.
