Section 1: Basic Wildland Firefighter Courses

Basic Firefighter II and WCT

Jan 11-15, Feb 22-26, Mar 15-19, Apr 5-9, May 10-14, Jun 7-11, Jul 5-9, Aug 9-13, Sep 13-17

Cost: \$200 per person

This 40-hour course includes S-130 Basic Firefighter Training; S-190 Introduction to Wildland Fire Behavior; L-180 Human Factors; I-100 Introduction to ICS; S-133 Look Up, Look Down, Look Around; and S-134 LCES. Fire shelter training will be provided and is required prior to certification as a Firefighter II (FFT2) under the Wildland Fire Qualification System. An arduous Work Capacity Test (WCT) will be provided on day two of this course. Running shoes and shorts are suggested. This course will also cover field exercises which require work pants, long-sleeved shirt and boots. Leather gloves and hard hat will be provided.

PREREQUISITE: None



RT-130 Combo: RT-130, WCT, 1st Aid/CPR

Jan 28-30, Feb 4-6, Mar 1-3, Apr 1-3, Apr 28-30, May 24-26, Jun 14-16, Jul 12-14

Cost: \$180 per person

RT-130 Combo: Annual Fireline Safety Refresher with Arduous Work Capacity Test and First Aid & CPR Training (course description on pg. 9) to receive a discounted rate. Dates are scheduled to run seamlessly as an all-inclusive 3-day training program starting with the WCT on the first day and ending with First Aid CPR on the third day.

PREREQUISITE: FFT2 Qualification Current

WCT: Work Capacity Test - Arduous

Jan 28, Feb 4, Mar 1, Apr 1, Apr 28, May 24, Jun 14, Jul 12

Cost: \$50 per person

The pack test is a 3-mile walk with a 45-pound vest. Test must be completed within 45 minutes. Successfully completing this test will meet NWCG requirements for fireline positions that require Arduous Fitness Level. Running shoes and shorts suggested.

PREREQUISITE: None

ERT130: 8 Hour Fireline Safety Refresher for Agency Contractors

Jan 23, Feb 12, Mar 5, Mar 13, Apr 10, Apr 17, Apr 23, May 7, May 15, May 22, Jun 18, Jul 16

Additional locations and dates may be available, check our web site for these updates.

Cost: \$60 per person

This course is designed to provide up to date fireline safety information specifically intended for agency contractors. The course curriculum is determined each year by the agencies and may differ from year to year. In general, this course will refresh skills in applying the risk management process and rules of engagement to recognize and mitigate hazards in the work environment, receive updates on current issues and fire shelter deployment practice. Upon completion of this course, the student will receive an agency completion card.

PREREQUISITE: None

RT-130: Annual Fireline Safety Refresher

Jan 28-29, Feb 4-5, Mar 1-2, Apr 1-2, Apr 28-29, May 24-25, Jun 14-15, Jul 12-13

Cost: \$80 per person

This 2-day course is designed to provide up to date fireline safety information. Refresh skills in applying the risk management process and rules of engagement to recognize and mitigate hazards in the work environment. Receive updates on current issues and fire shelter deployment practice. Satisfies annual requirement to maintain current firefighter certification. (Does not include WCT)

PREREQUISITE: FFT2 Qualification Current

Section 2: Firefighter I Courses

S-131: Firefighter Type I Training

Jan 22, Mar 15, Jun 4, Oct 28

Cost: \$90 per person

This interactive course is designed to meet the training needs of the Firefighter Type I (FFTI). It contains several tactical decision games designed to facilitate learning the objectives and class discussion. Topics include fireline reference materials, communications and tactical decision making.

PREREQUISITE: S-130/S-190; FFT2 Qualified



S-211: Portable Pumps and Water Use

Jan 19-21, Mar 22-24, Jun 1-3, Oct 25-27

Cost: \$175 per person

This course consists of three skill areas: supply, delivery and application of water; basic hydraulics, and equipment care. Field exercise requires set up, operation and maintenance of pump equipment. Closed book, written final examination.

PREREQUISITE: None



S-212: Wildland Fire Chain Saws

Jan 25-27, Mar 16-18, May 19-21, Oct 18-20

Cost: \$185 per person

Course lessons provide introduction to the function, maintenance and use of internal combustion engine powered chainsaws and their tactical wildland fire application. Field exercises support entry level training for firefighters with little or no previous experience in operating a chainsaw, providing hands-on cutting experience in surroundings similar to fireline situations. Students will be required to provide the following PPE: long-sleeved shirt, work pants, 8" leather boots. All other equipment will be provided.

** Successful completion for entry level does not constitute Certified Faller designation

PREREQUISITE: FFT2 Qualified, Current Certification in Basic First Aid and CPR

Section 3:

Advanced Courses for Crew Boss & Above

S-200: Initial Attack Incident Commander

Feb 1-2, Mar 25-26, May 17-18, Oct 21-22

Cost: \$130 per person

This course is designed to meet the training needs of the IC Type 4. It is presented in a discussion/exercise format. The six instructional units cover foundation skills, intelligence gathering and documentation, sizing up the incident, developing a plan of action, post-fire activities, evaluating incident objectives and managing the incident. Evaluation of the student is by unit tests and performance based evaluations.

PREREQUISITE: *Qualified as any SRB*



S-215: Fire Operations in the Wildland/Urban Interface

Mar 23-26

Cost: \$240 per person

This 32-hour course is designed to assist structural and wildland firefighters who will be making tactical decisions when confronting wildland fire that threatens life, property and improvements in the wildland/urban interface. Units include size-up, initial strategy and incident action plan, structure triage, structure protection tactics, incident action plan assessment, follow-up and public relations, and firefighter safety in the interface.

PREREQUISITE: *FFTI Qualified; S-230 recommended*



S-230: Crew Boss – Single Resource

Mar 1-3, Mar 8-10, Nov 1-3

Cost: \$185 per person

The 24-hour classroom course is designed to meet the training needs of a crew boss on a wildland fire incident. Topics include preparation, mobilization, tactics and safety, offline duties, demobilization and post incident responsibilities.

PREREQUISITE: *S-290, FFTI Qualified, Completion of Pre-Course Work*

S-231: Engine Boss – Single Resource

Mar 4-5, Mar 11-12, Nov 4-5

Cost: \$130 per person

This is a skill course designed to produce student proficiency in the performance of the duties associated with engine boss, single resource (ENGB). Topics include: engine and crew capabilities and limitations, information sources, fire size-up considerations, tactics and wildland/urban interface.

PREREQUISITE: *S-230, FFTI Qualified*



S-234: Ignition Operations

Apr 19-20, Nov 8-9

Cost: \$250 per person

This entry level course provides training in the functional roles and responsibilities connected with firing operations. This course covers planning, ignition procedures and techniques, and equipment applicable to wildland prescribed fire. This course also addresses the role of the ignition specialist or firing boss as the organization manages escalation from a non-complex to a complex fire situation.

PREREQUISITE: *S-290, Completion of Pre-Course Work.*

Section 3:

Advanced Courses for Crew Boss & Above

S-270: Basic Air Operations

Apr 8-9, Dec 2-3

Cost: \$140 per person

This course covers aircraft types and capabilities, aviation management and safety for flying in and working with agency aircraft, tactical and logistical uses of aircraft, and requirements for helicopter take-off and landing areas. The regulations, procedures and policies addressed in this course are primarily those governing federal agency and ICS operations.

PREREQUISITE: *Completion of Pre-Course Work.*



S-290: Intermediate Wildland Fire Behavior

Feb 22-25, Mar 1-4, Nov 15-18

Cost: \$250 per person

Designed to meet the training requirements to work in ICS Operations as a Single Resource Boss, this course instructs prospective fireline supervisors in wildland fire behavior for effective and safe fire management operations.

PREREQUISITE: *S-190, Completion of Pre-Course Work.*

S-330: Task Force/Strike Team Leader

Feb 16-19

Cost: \$265 per person

This course meets the training requirements for Task Force and Strike Team Leader positions. The class is open to Single Resource Bosses and Initial Attack Incident Commanders.

PREREQUISITE: *SRB Qualified, Completion of Pre-Course Work.*

S-336: Tactical Decision Making In Wildland Fire

Feb 8-11

Cost: \$300 per person

This course is designed primarily to prepare experienced Single Resource Bosses and Initial Attack Incident Commanders in the tactics necessary at the Strike Team/Task Force Leader level. It is also valuable for operations supervisors qualified at higher management levels who have not received training in wildfire suppression tactics.

PREREQUISITE: *SRB or ICT4 Qualified, Completion of Pre-Course Work.*

S-390: Introduction To Wildland Fire Behavior Calculations

TBA - Call for availability

Cost: \$300 per person

This 32-hour course is designed to introduce fire behavior calculations by manual methods using nomograms and the Fire Behavior Handbook Appendix B. The student gains an understanding of the determinants of fire behavior through studying inputs (weather, slope, fuels and fuel moisture). The student also learns how to interpret fire behavior outputs, documentation processes and fire behavior briefing components.

PREREQUISITE: *SRB or ICT4 Qualified, Completion of Pre-Course Work.*

L-280: Followership to Leadership

Mar 30-31

Cost: \$137 per person

This training course is designed as a self-assessment opportunity for individuals preparing to step into a leadership role. The course combines one day of classroom instruction followed by a second day in the field with students working through a series of problem solving events in small teams. Topics include: leadership values and principles, transition challenges for new leaders, situational leadership, team cohesion factors, ethical decision-making and after action review techniques.

PREREQUISITE: *L-180, Experience on incident assignments in operations or support functions, Completion of Pre-Course Work.*

Section 3:

Advanced Courses for Crew Boss & Above

I-200: Basic ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents

Mar 29-30

Cost: \$170 per person

This 16-hour course introduces students to the principles of the Incident Command System (ICS) associated with incident related performance. Topics include leadership and management, delegation of authority and management by objectives, functional areas and positions, briefings, organizational flexibility, transitions and transfers. National Incident Management System (NIMS) compliant.

PREREQUISITE: None

I-300: Intermediate ICS for Supervisors and Expanding Incidents

Apr 5-7

Cost: \$250 per person

This 24-hour course provides description and detail of the Incident Command System (ICS) organization and operations in supervisory roles on expanding or Type 3 Incidents. Topics include ICS fundamentals review, incident/event assessment and agency guidance in establishing incident objectives, Unified Command, incident resource management, planning process, demobilization, transfer of command and close out. National Incident Management System (NIMS) compliant.

PREREQUISITE: I-200

RX-301: Prescribed Fire Implementation

TBA Call for Availability

Cost \$250 per person

This course is designed to introduce student to the tools and techniques used to perform in the role of a prescribed fire burn boss. The course material is based on the tasks found in the position task book for prescribed fire burn boss. It leads the student through the duties and responsibilities associated with the position of the prescribed fire burn boss including evaluation and implementation of a prescribed fire plan.

Prerequisite: Qualified as FIRB, ICT4, Completed S-390, Proficient in the use of BehavePlus and Completion of Pre-Course Work.



Section 4: Medical Training

1STAID: Basic First Aid and CPR Training

Jan 30, Feb 6, Mar 3, Apr 3, Apr 30, May 26, Jun 16, Jul 14

Cost: \$80 per person

The purpose of this course is to give individuals the knowledge and skills necessary to recognize and provide basic first aid care for respiratory and cardiac emergencies for adults, children and infants until advanced medical personnel arrive on scene. Card issued by the American Safety & Health Institute.

PREREQUISITE: None



1STR: First Responder Medical Training

Apr 12-16, Dec 6-10

Cost: \$365 per person

This course will teach you to assess a patient and determine what medical care is necessary while enhancing your ability to make appropriate decisions when faced with an emergency. This level of First Aid training is a minimum requirement for all Police and Fire Departments.

PREREQUISITE: Basic 1st Aid and CPR Certified
