

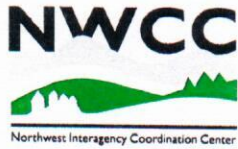

- 2,024 fires were caused by lightning. 1,482 fires were human-caused burning 140,987 acres.
- In Oregon, the largest fire/complex was the Buzzard Complex for a total of 395,747 acres about half the size of Rhode Island or 618 square miles.
- The largest fire/complex in Washington was the Carlton Complex at 256,108 acres. There was 180 miles of fireline, the distance from Portland to Seattle.
- The total cost to date exceeds \$458 million, Oregon \$278 million and Washington \$180 million.
- The NW had a record setting 43 days at #1 on the National Incident Management Situation Report (IMSR).
- The NW stayed at preparedness level 5 for 31 days; the previous record was set in 2006 for 24 days.
- ^{7.0}~~5.5~~ million gallons of fire retardant was dropped from 5 air tanker bases throughout the region. This figure was more than double the 20 year average retardant use in the region.
- The NW cataloged over 6.5 million hours of firefighter exposure this year. Equivalent to 3,125 people working for a full year.
- During the peak fire activity the Northwest region had
 - 19 Type I and II Incident Management Teams assigned along with 6 Type IIIs
 - Over 12,000 firefighters and support personnel
 - 900,000 active fire acres
 - 35 Interagency Hotshot Crews from all over the nation
 - 550 Engines
- No Operational Fatalities
- Fuels Treated:
Forest Service = Unified Target – 203,750, WFSU – 43,272, CFLN – 30,830 and ARRA – 231
Total – 278,704 acres
BLM = 63,000 acres
- Flight Hours = 15,528 in the PNW more than 6,000 more than 2013
- 5 National Prevention Teams were assigned in the PNW

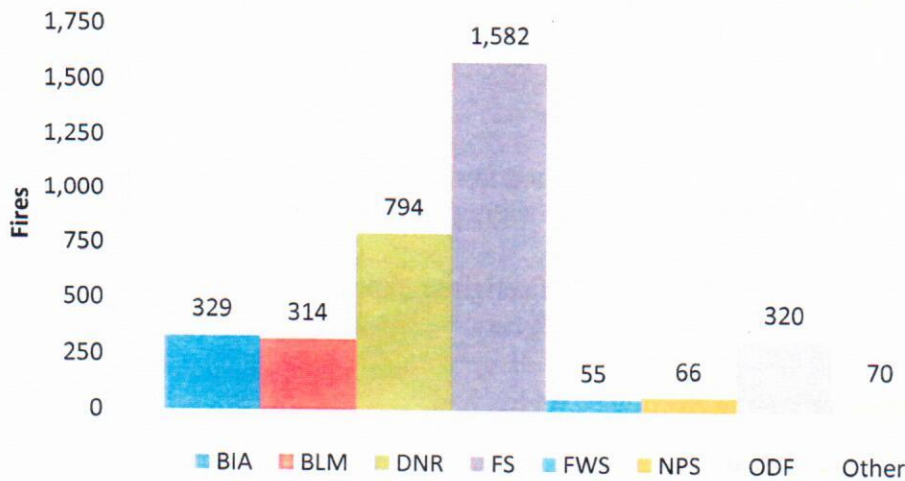
***Note, not all dispatch offices have reported all their fires for the season. Numbers in charts and statistics are not final until calendar year end and are subject to change.**



2014 Northwest Year-to-Date Fire Statistics November 14, 2014

- 1,260,088 acres in the Northwest (NW) have been consumed by wildfire, 846,945 in Oregon and 413,143 in Washington.
- 3,506 fires have been reported in the Northwest region with 93 meeting the criteria of a large fire, 58 in Oregon and 35 in Washington.
