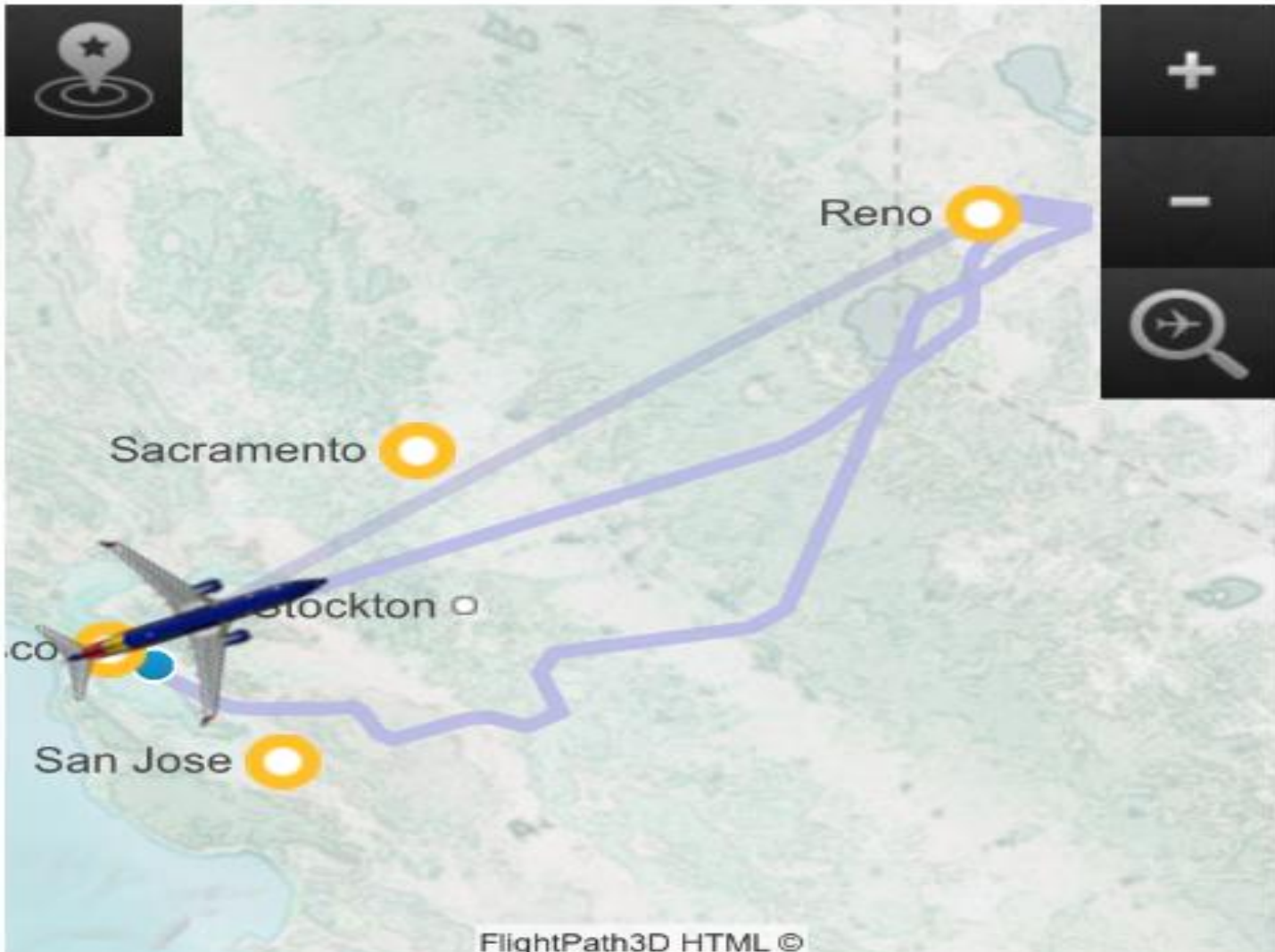

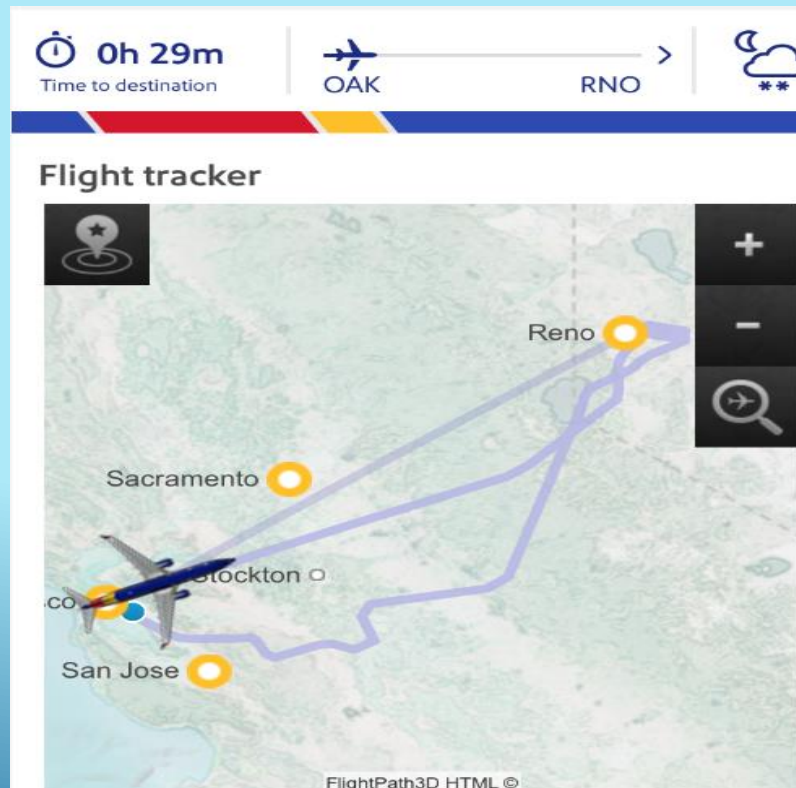

2017 IFCA AWARD



Agreement Award: June 2017

60 - Companies

238 - Total Crews

54 - Designated Dispatch Locations (DDLs)

The IFCA may be renewed up to three 1-year Extensions each spring.

The first Extension will be effective May 01, 2018 through April 30, 2019.



Amendment

- An Amendment will be issued this spring to incorporate the US Dept. of Labor Wage Determination directly into the IFCA specifications.

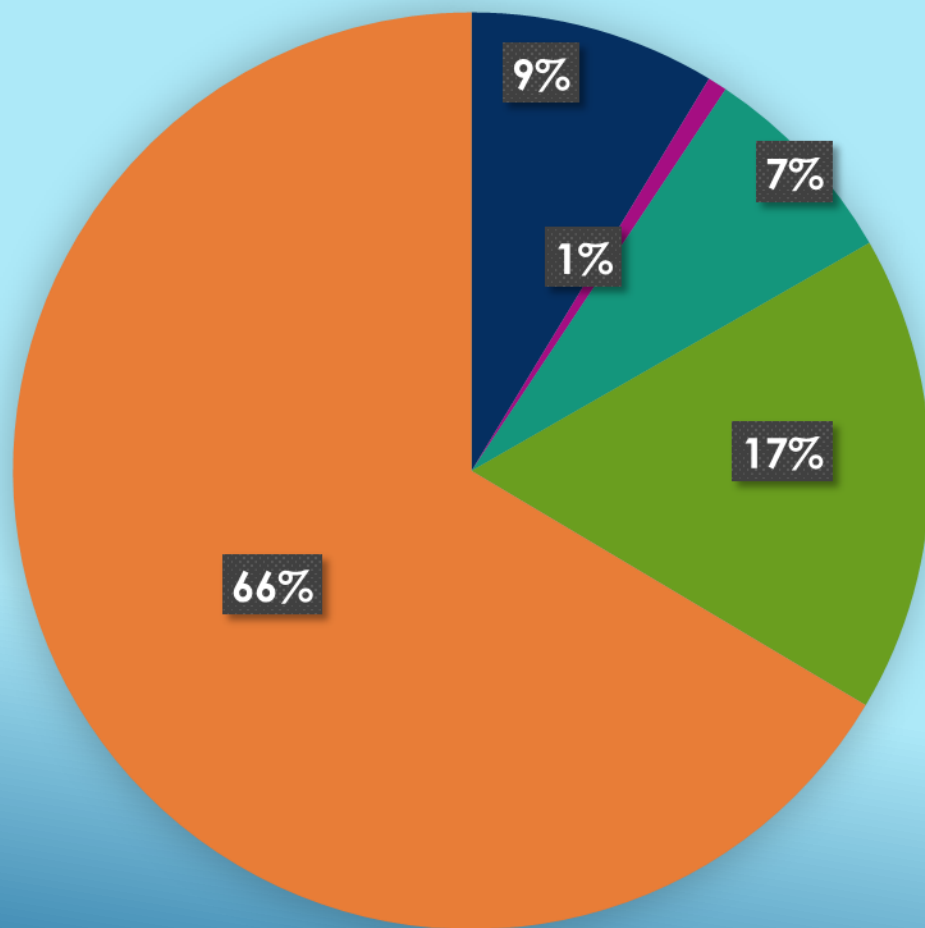
2017 FIRE SEASON - IFCA CREW DEPLOYMENTS

Number of Crews Deployed:		204
Number of Incidents Crews were deployed on:		213
Number of Deployments (includes reassignments)		1100
1-14 day assignments	-	1010 (approx.)
Extended assignments	-	90 (approx.)
Total Number of Crew Days:		9649

Crews were deployed to incidents managed by USFS, BLM, BIA, ODF, WDNR, WSFM, States of AZ, CA, ID, MT, NV, and UT.

During late October and again in December, crews were deployed to assist with firefighting efforts in Northern and Southern California, respectively, on late season incidents.
