- S-I30



- Alpha test course expected in fall 2018
- New simulations, less PowerPoint
- More hands-on format for instructor based presentation
- Running behind on the process

UPDATES CONTINUED

- S-I 90



- NWCG is working on a new instructor based version
- Alpha version due out spring 2018
- Further along in development than S-I 30
- PowerPoint slides are being sent to instructors for review
